

## 2025-2026 REGISTRATION FORM ADVANCED 3 YEAR OLD PRESCHOOL (AGES 3-4 YEARS)

#### **PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:**

Ms. Heather's Advanced Preschool for children ages 3-4 will begin on Tuesday, September 2, 2025. The last day of the program will be Tuesday, May 19, 2026. This program will be offered four days a week – Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday from 9:00-12:30. Morning carpool starts at 8:30 a.m. There will also be optional enrichment classes offered from 12:30-1:30 each day.

Each child will participate in developmentally appropriate activities for his or her age level. This preschool experience will emphasize growth in language and literacy, math concepts, science, social studies, arts, health and physical development, and social and emotional growth.

This private program is for children ages 3-4 years old. Students must be three years old as of September 1, 2025 to attend this class. The Registration Fee of \$450 per child is a non-refundable and non-transferable fee, which reserves your child's spot in the program. It is used to order art supplies, classroom necessities, school book bags, school teeshirts, school year subscriptions to a weekly preschool magazine, and so much more! The annual tuition can be paid monthly in the amount of \$425 for the months of September-May if all payments are made by the 1<sup>st</sup> of every month when the monthly installment is due. Tuition is due on the first day of each month with late fees beginning on the 5<sup>th</sup> of each month. Absences will not result in a reduction of tuition as registration is for the full school year (9 months). Your child will have the advantage of receiving a quality preschool education in a very small setting with experienced and nurturing teachers.

Parents will be asked to pack a healthy lunch for their children. Parents will also be asked 2-3 times during the year to provide a large box of crackers, cereal or other healthy snack for the children to share as a mid-morning snack. Children must be completely potty trained to attend the 3's preschool program.

Mandatory Evaluations for all new students!

All new students entering MHEA or MAEV will be required to attend one mandatory evaluation day in March for placement for the 2025-2026 school year. If your child currently attends MHEA or MAEV, your child is exempt from this assessment.

You will receive more detailed information in early March.

**CURRICULUM DETAILS:** The program will focus on the following Georgia Pre-K objectives:

#### **Literacy Development:**

- Obj. #1 Children will develop skills in listening for the purpose of comprehension.
- Obj. #2 Children will learn to discriminate the sounds of language (phonological awareness letter sounds, rhymes, poems, etc.)
- Obj. #3 Children will develop an understanding of new vocabulary introduced in conversations, activities, stories or books.
- Obj. #4 Children will develop and expand expressive language skills.
- Obj. #5 Children will begin to develop age-appropriate strategies that will assist in reading.
- Obj. #6 Children will begin to develop age-appropriate writing skills.

#### **Mathematical Development:**

- Obj. #1 Children will begin to develop an understanding of numbers (counting to 30, ordinal numbers, arranging sets of objects in one-to-one correspondence, estimation, counting, sorting and naming coins, etc.).
- Obj. #2 Children will create and duplicate simple patterns.
- Obj. #3 Children will sort and classify objects.
- Obj. #4 Children will develop a sense of space (positions, directions, distances and order) and an understanding of basic geometric shapes.
- Obj. #5 Children will learn how to use a variety of non-standard and standard means of measurement.

#### **Scientific Development:**

- Obj. #1 Children will use the processes of science to actively explore, investigate, observe and record changes in the environment.
- Obj. #2 Children will acquire scientific knowledge related to life science (life cycles, plants, animals, etc.).
- Obj. #3 Children will acquire scientific knowledge related to physical science (basic chemistry & astronomy).
- Obj. #4 Children will acquire scientific knowledge related to earth science (geology, paleontology, etc.).
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#### **Social Studies Development:**

- Obj. #1 Children will develop an appreciation of his/her role as a member of the family, the classroom and the community.
- Obj. #2 Children will develop a respect for differences in people, geographic regions and cultures.
- Obj. #3 Children will express beginning geographic thinking.

#### **Creative Development:**

- Obj. #1 Children will explore and use a variety of materials to develop artistic activities.
- Obj. #2 Children will develop curiosity, initiative, self-direction and persistence.
- Obj. #3 Children will increase the capacity for self-control.
- Obj. #4 Children will develop interpersonal and social skills for relating with other members of the learning community.

#### **Health and Physical Development:**

- Obj. #1 Children will participate in a variety of gross-motor activities to develop control, balance, strength and coordination.
- Obj. #2 Children will participate in activities that foster fine motor development.
- Obj. #3 Children will understand healthy and safe living practices.

#### **Christian Development:**

- Obj. #1 Children will learn Bible stories and songs through interactive activities.
- Obj. #2 Children will learn how to respect and love each other as they grow socially and emotionally.
- Obj. #3 Children will learn to treat others as they would want to be treated.
- Obj. #4 Children will complete simple crafts related to the Bible stories.

	<b>Tuition</b> : By initialing here and signing below, I understand that enrollment in the preschool is for the entire 9 months of the school year and that the tuition is annual which can be paid monthly if payments are made by the 1 <sup>st</sup> of the month. <b>Tuition of \$3,825 for the four day preschool program is paid over nine months beginning September 1st, 2025 in the amount of \$425 per month.</b> If the annual tuition is made in one payment by September 5th, a 3% discount will be given. Tuition paid in full for the four day program is \$3710.25, which reflects a total savings of \$114.75.
	<b>Monthly Tuition Payment Due Dates and Late Fees:</b> By initialing here and signing below, I understand and agree to pay the monthly amount of the annual tuition by the 1 <sup>st</sup> of the month by cash or check as well as a late fee of \$5 per day after a three-day grace period (late fees will begin on payments made on the 5 <sup>th</sup> of the month). No exceptions will be made to keep this fair for all parents during the school year.
	Additional Payment Option & Fees: By initialing here and signing below, I am stating that I understand there are several payment options:  1) Checks or Cash: Checks can be written to Ms. Heather's Educational Adventures or MHEA.
	2) <b>Venmo:</b> There is an option for parents to pay via Venmo. The Venmo account information is heather-langley-12
	3) <b>Zelle:</b> There is an option for parents to pay via Zelle. The Zelle account information is 678-936-6534.
	4) <b>PayPal</b> : There is an option for parents to pay with PayPa, but it must include an additional 5% charge. If you elect to complete a payment using this method, you will need to add an additional 5% of the balance due to the amount paid.
	5) Automatic Credit Card Processing: There is an option for parents to leave a credit card on file at the school to be processed on every 1 <sup>st</sup> of the month when tuition is due. If you elect to complete payment using this method, you will need to add an additional 5% of the balance due to the amount paid. A credit card authorization form must be completed and signed.
	<b>Returned Check Fee:</b> By initialing here and signing below, I agree to pay \$35 for returned checks as the school incurs bank fees and administrative expenses related to returned checks.
	A 60 day written notice must be provided for a student needing to withdraw from the program. The full tuition amount will need to be paid for those 60 days
